Registration Fee

The competitor entry fee for the 2005 World Masters Games is \$185.00 CAD. **Register before 22 July 2004 and pay only \$160.00 CAD.**

There are additional surcharges for some sports. There will be an additional sport fee of \$50.00 CAD for those who would like to compete in more than one sport.
